Shipping your parts:

- To ensure your parts arrive intact and undamaged, ensure they are fully padded and wrapped when being packed. Parts that can contact other parts and move freely are likely to be damaged (cosmetically or functionally) in transit.
- Ensure that you are using a box in good condition, and not re-using a damaged box.
- Include a copy of your original invoice in the box with the parts to ensure we know what they are for.
 - We highly recommend attaching an inventory list of what you have sent, along with any additional notes/instructions/information, to this invoice.
- When you ship your parts, use a service that provides a tracking number, and ensure that you save it. This will be vital for locating the package if there is any issue with delivery.
 - We highly recommend insuring your package for the actual value of the parts you are sending to us. (We will automatically insure the package when shipping back to you).
 - USPS, UPS, and FedEx all deliver to us without issue. Ship using your preferred carrier.
- Once your package has arrived, you will receive an email from the gunsmiths within two (2) business days confirming receipt. If you do not receive this email, please contact armory@rainierarms.com or call 253-218-2999 Ext. 3 with your name, order number, the tracking number for the package, and a description of the box so that we can confirm delivery.
